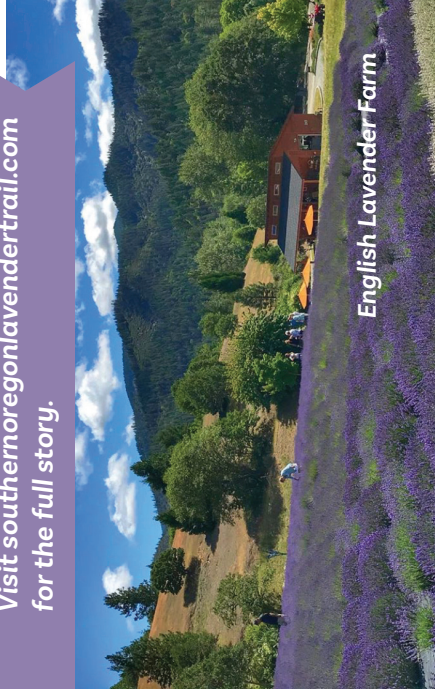

Southern Oregon Lavender Festival Weekends

June 19-21 and July 10-12

6 am-4 pm daily at participating farms

Each summer, the farms of the Southern Oregon Lavender Trail open their gates for two memorable weekends celebrating lavender in all its forms. The June festival takes place at peak bloom, when rows of violet stretch across the landscape and the air carries a gentle fragrance. Each farm offers its own welcoming experience, with thoughtfully planned activities, seasonal refreshments, and artisan lavender goods to enjoy throughout the day.

By July, the focus turns to harvest. Many farms invite guests to take part in u-pick, gathering fresh lavender straight from the field. Along the way, you may create a lavender wreath, learn which varieties grow best at home, or watch the traditional process of distilling lavender into essential oil.

These festivals have become a beloved part of Southern Oregon's seasonal rhythm. We invite you to slow down, explore at your own pace, and enjoy the simple beauty of lavender in bloom—an experience meant to be savored and remembered.

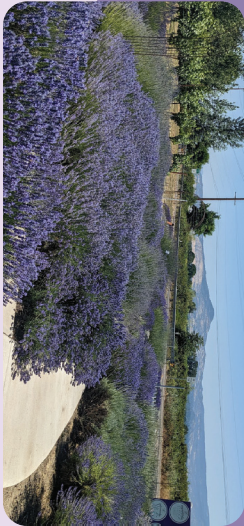

Just 5 minutes from Interstate 5, Lush Lavender Farm offers a boutique lavender experience with a specialty nursery, charming farm shop, and seasonal u-pick. Located across from the Rogue River, the farm provides a peaceful and scenic setting to enjoy lavender in bloom.

The Lavender Demonstration Garden

The Lavender Demonstration Garden at the OSU Extension office in Central Point features 80-100 varieties and 250+ plants, showcasing diverse colors and textures suited to the Rogue Valley climate. Designed and maintained by OSU Extension Master Gardeners, it demonstrates how lavender can thrive with full sun, lean soil, and minimal water —while providing rich habitat for bees, butterflies, and other pollinators. As part of the Southern Oregon Lavender Trail and the only lavender garden in the Pacific Northwest registered with the Herb Society of America, it offers visitors inspiring ideas for home landscapes, as well as opportunities to learn about pruning, propagating, and using lavender for culinary, craft, and ornamental purposes.

So, what is the Southern Oregon Lavender Trail?

The Southern Oregon Lavender Trail (SOLT) is a self-guided journey connecting a collection of lavender farms across one of the region's most scenic landscapes. Rather than a single destination, the trail invites you to wander from farm to farm, discovering the character and creativity behind each stop. Set against a backdrop of wild rivers, rolling hills, and a celebrated wine region, Southern Oregon has become an unexpected haven for lavender. In bloom, the farms bring a soft wash of color and fragrance to the countryside, adding a distinctive beauty to an already remarkable place.

Experiences along the trail are as varied as the farms themselves. Visitors can gather fresh lavender in u-pick fields, watch the distillation of essential oil, or take part in hands-on workshops like wreath making. Some come to learn, others to linger—but every visit offers a deeper connection to the craft.

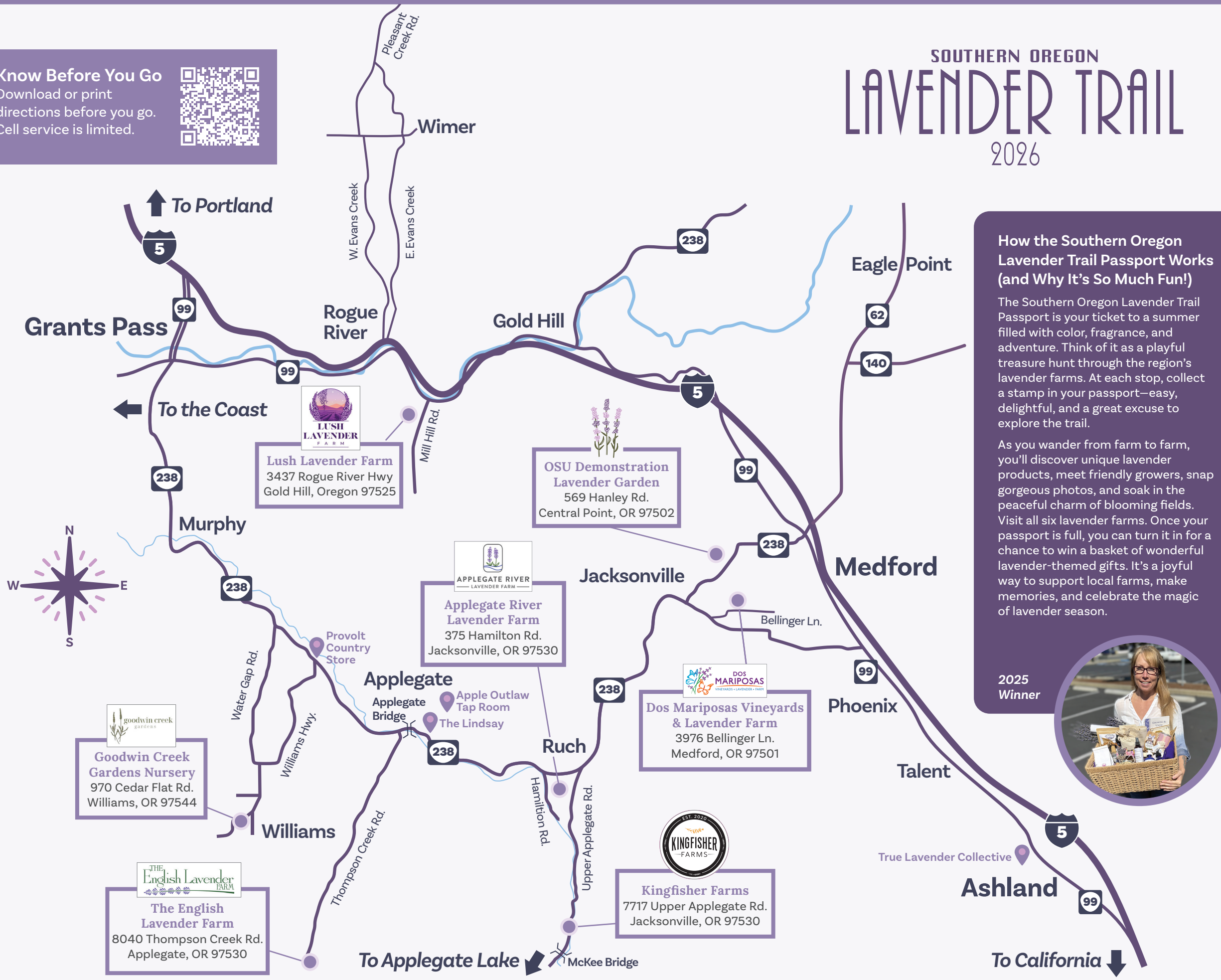
